Joe's best Wyoming Area Football memory is winning the 2012 District 2 Championship against Lakeland.

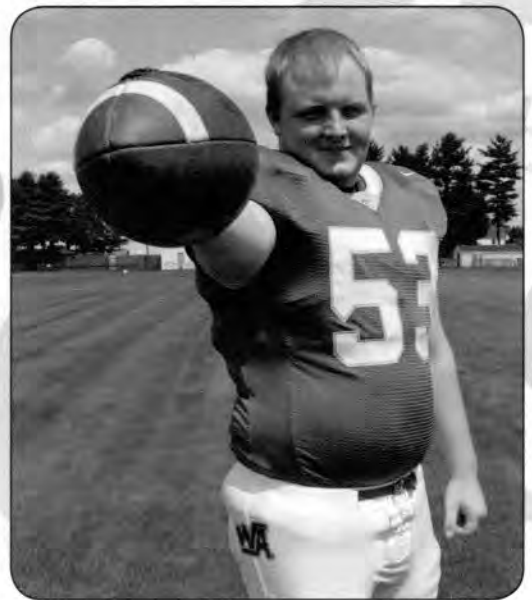

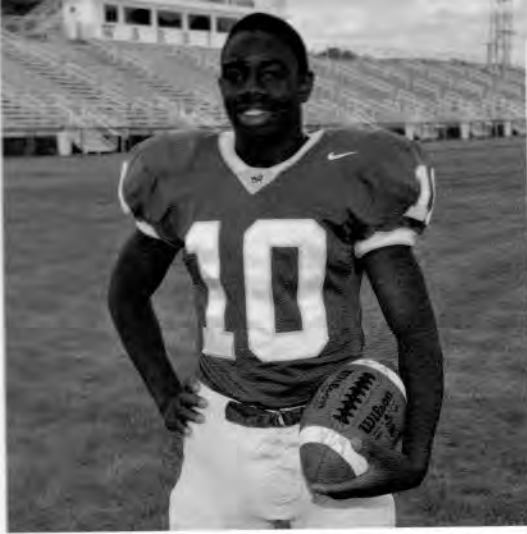
Joe's favorite food is pizza and absolutely loves Pizza Bella because it is just awesome!

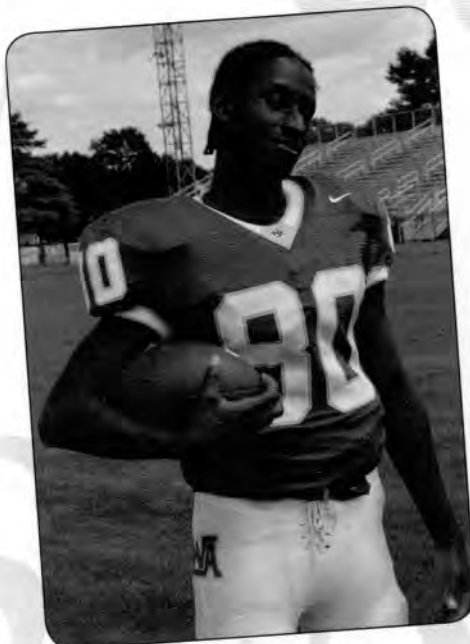
Randall says that his least favorite WA Football play is the one where he does not get the ball, and does not like drills where he is not a wide receiver

Steven says that his least favorite WA Football play is “GAP,” because it is a tough assignment at his position.

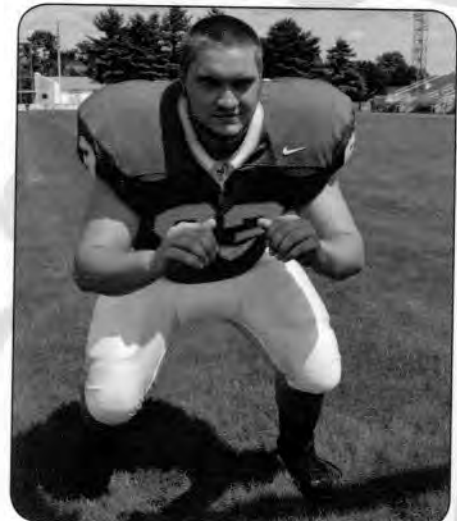
His absolute favorite WA Football memory, hands down, was the Warriors becoming the 2012 PIAA District 2 AA Champions in his junior year.

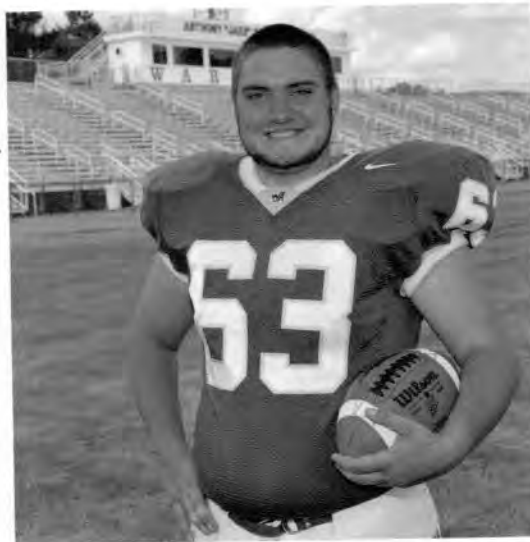

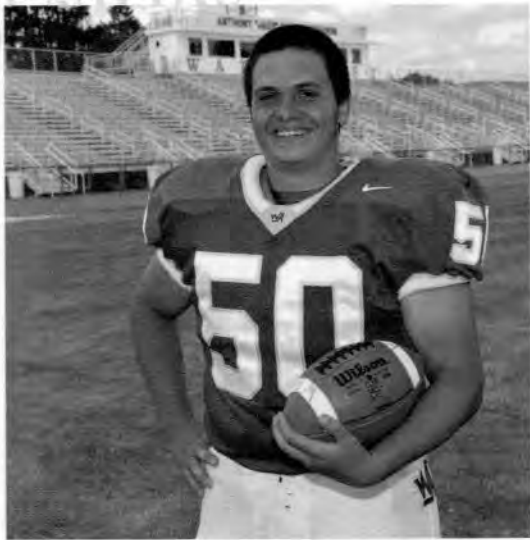

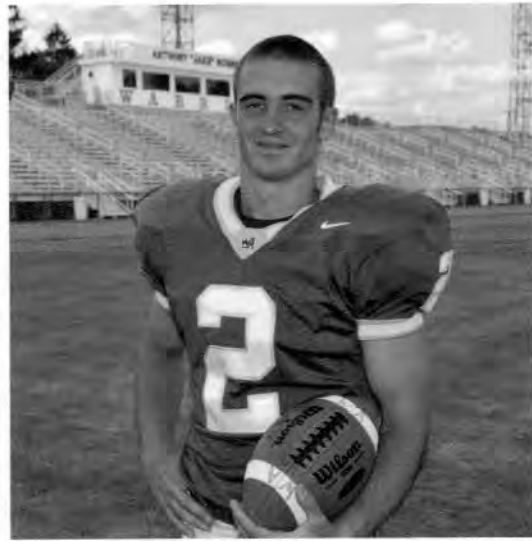
His favorite thing to hear Coach Spencer say is "Two Chainz and a Whistle," and absolutely does not like to run "GAP" plays or GAP drills.

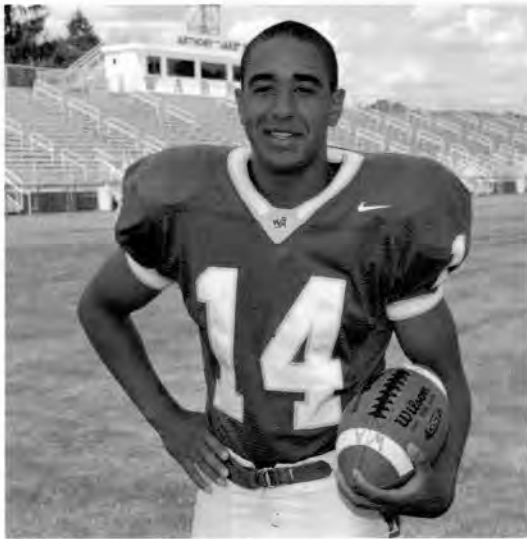
The best thing that he ever heard in the WA Football "film room" is: "Tyler you're compromising my defense!"

Jeremy decided to play WA Football because he thinks that it is a great football program at Wyoming Area and a great sport.

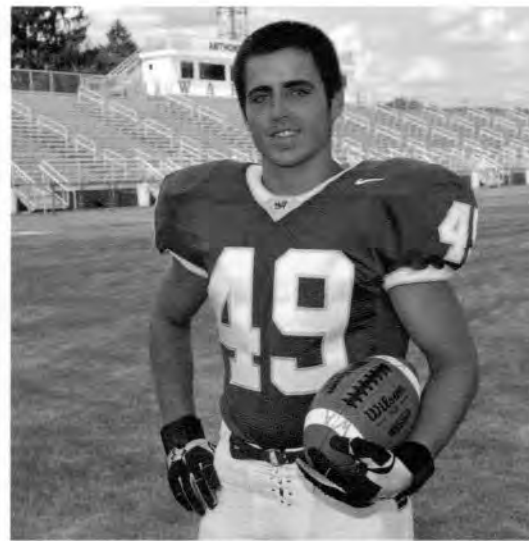
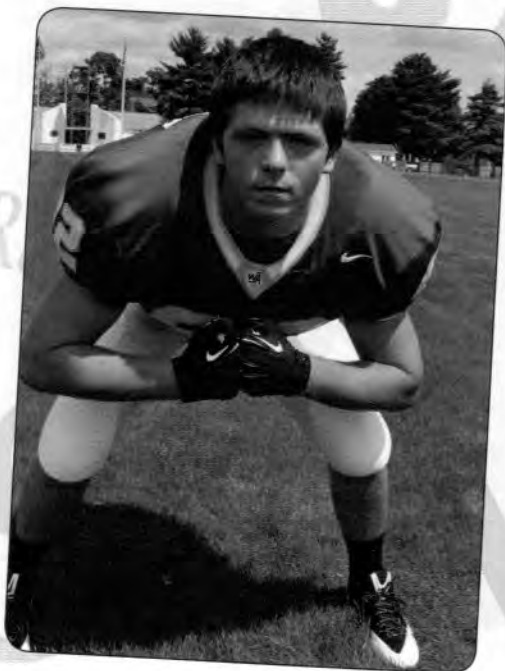
Jeremy loves the Wyoming Area football games and the crowds and environments that surround the Friday night games.

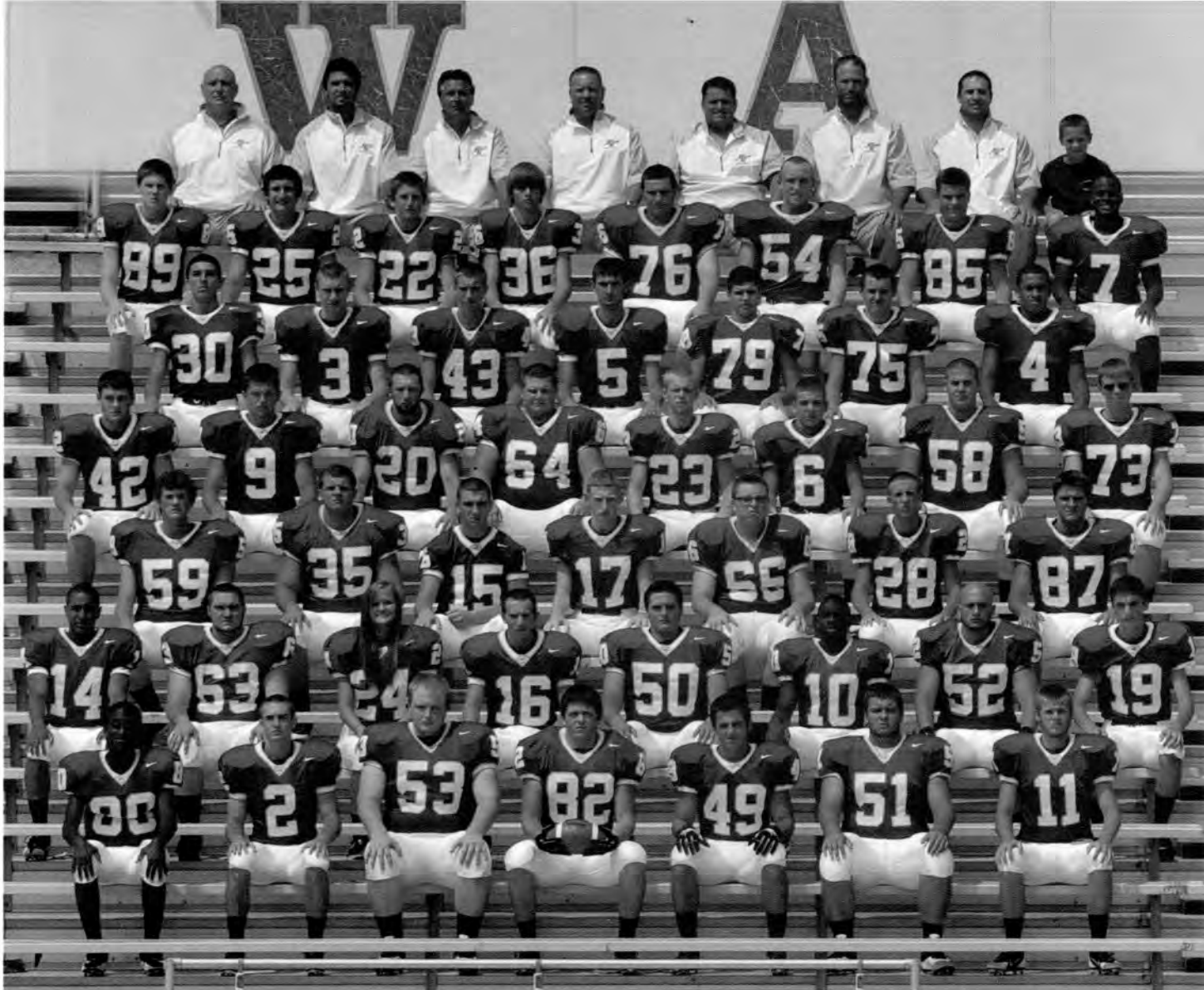
Danielle's favorite Wyoming Area football coach is Coach Marianacci because "he always encourages me to do my best and he is comical."
